**THIS WEEK-Create a drawing or painting of stuff you find around you.**

- Look carefully at what you draw but don't worry too much about where it goes on the picture plane.
- Look at the object from different angles and juxtapose them with other things you like or love.
- Fill your picture plane with objects but don't worry too much about the sizes, small things could be big in your picture and big things small.
- Think about adding colour if you fancy, any media will do, what do you have lying around.

### SOME SUGGESTIONS TO HELP

- Choose interesting objects, shoes, bottles, hats, socks, ornaments etc....
- Avoid things with quite boring shapes like phones, laptops
- Add tone to your work with crosshatching
- Think about how you light your work, even though his work is quite cartoony his objects are still worked into with light and dark.
- Have fun and express yourself.
